## STUDENT CONDUCT

The Board has a responsibility to establish, in agreement with the School Act and Regulations, the standard of conduct expected of the students of the district. In an effort to provide all students with a safe positive learning environment, the District Code of Conduct formalizes expectations for student behaviour, and individual school codes of conduct are developed within the framework of the district code. It is important for students and parents to be aware of district and school-wide expectations pertaining to student behaviour. In the first days of the school year teachers work to make sure students understand expectations. In addition to this, we would like to make you aware of the following Board policies:

### **Student Involvement with Illegal Drugs and Alcohol (9.120)**

The Board opposes any involvement or association with illegal drugs or alcohol on school property or at school functions both within the district and on school travel or off school property. Any cases of pupil involvement or association with drugs or alcohol shall result in suspension to the Board. The Board may impose a suspension of twenty (20) days, more or less to reflect the nature and seriousness of the circumstances.

### **Bullying/Intimidation (9.235)**

The Board considers any act of bullying or intimidation, including internet, texting etc., to be a serious threat to the school environment and to the safety of students and staff. Administrators and staff shall make all reasonable attempts to minimize the risk of injury to any member of the school community and to take appropriate disciplinary and/or remedial action in accordance with the circumstances and seriousness of the offence.

### **Weapons at School (9.700)**

The Board considers the possession or use of any weapon by people on school property to be a serious threat to the school environment and to the safety of both students and staff. The definition of a weapon shall be at the discretion of the school staff. The Board shall take appropriate action and/or lay charges against any individual so involved.
